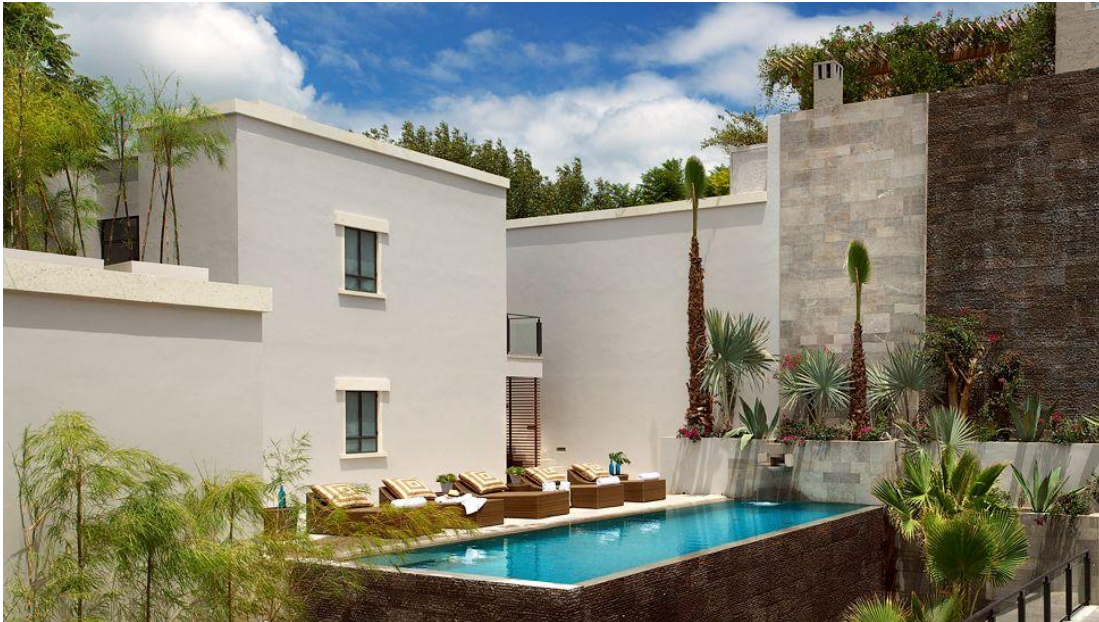

Hotel Matilda



In the center of one of [Mexico](#)'s most impressive colonial cities is Hotel Matilda. It is a luxurious hotel that presents the enchanting beauty of San Miguel de Allende's rich history.
